More cold crop vegetables have arrived. broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, & brussel sprouts

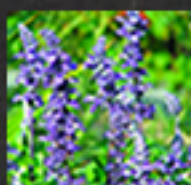
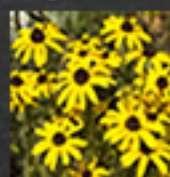
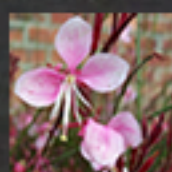
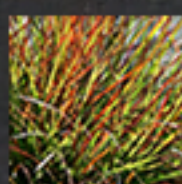
